For everyone who enjoys our ski resort, please follow the rules & regulations written.

Sliding is dangerous, and danger exists in ski resorts, both in weather and in controlled areas. In case of unforeseen circumstances, please be aware that 1 No skiing or snowboarding in prohibited areas as shown on both damage may occur to the customer and that damage will not be compensated by the ski resort manager. ski area and topographical maps. Avalanches can be easily be triggered. Missed trails as well as climbing slips and rock slides occur in this area, Prohibited area is out of our management, rescue operation or searches from the ski area cannot be made if you are outside of the marked trails.
